● CCTV Camera Location



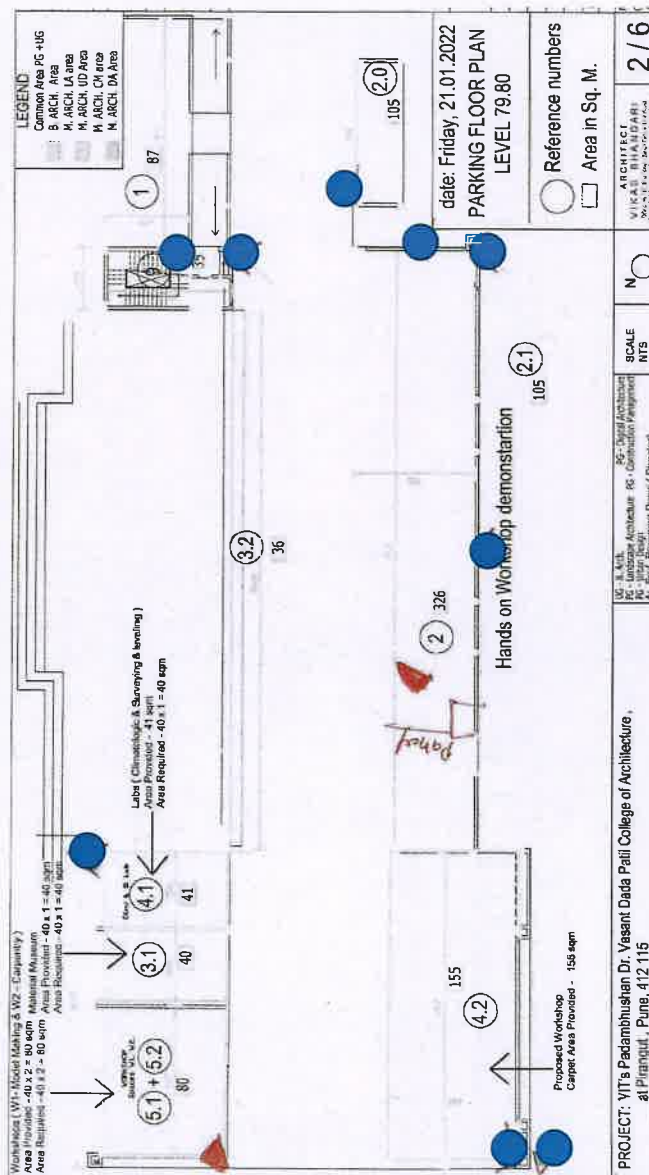
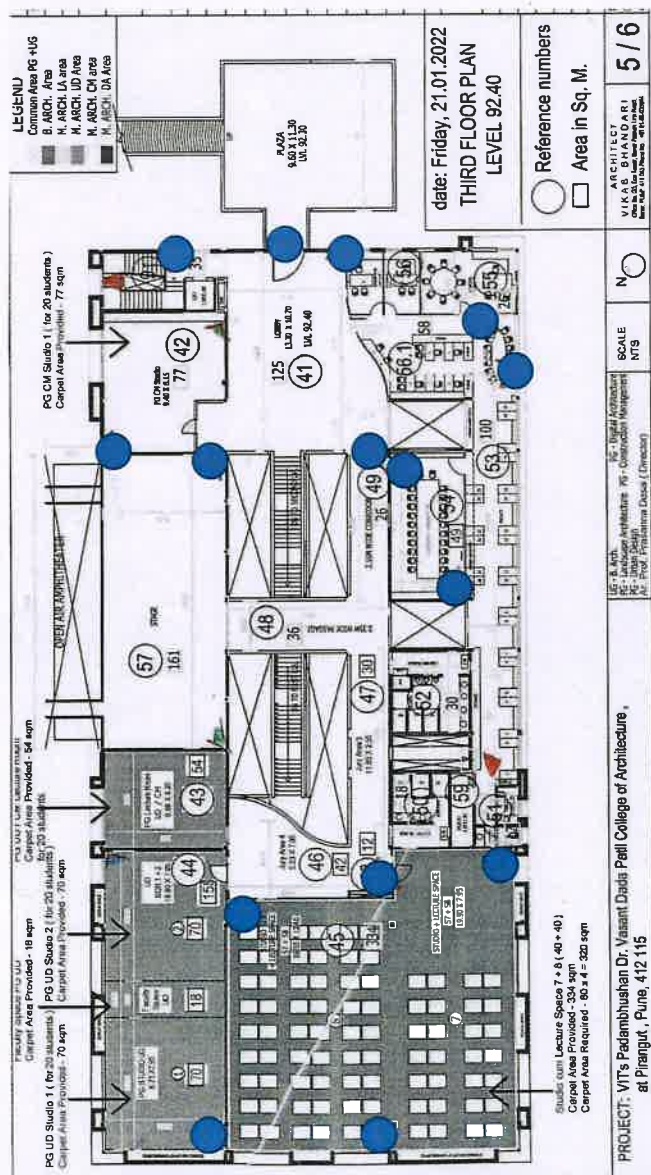

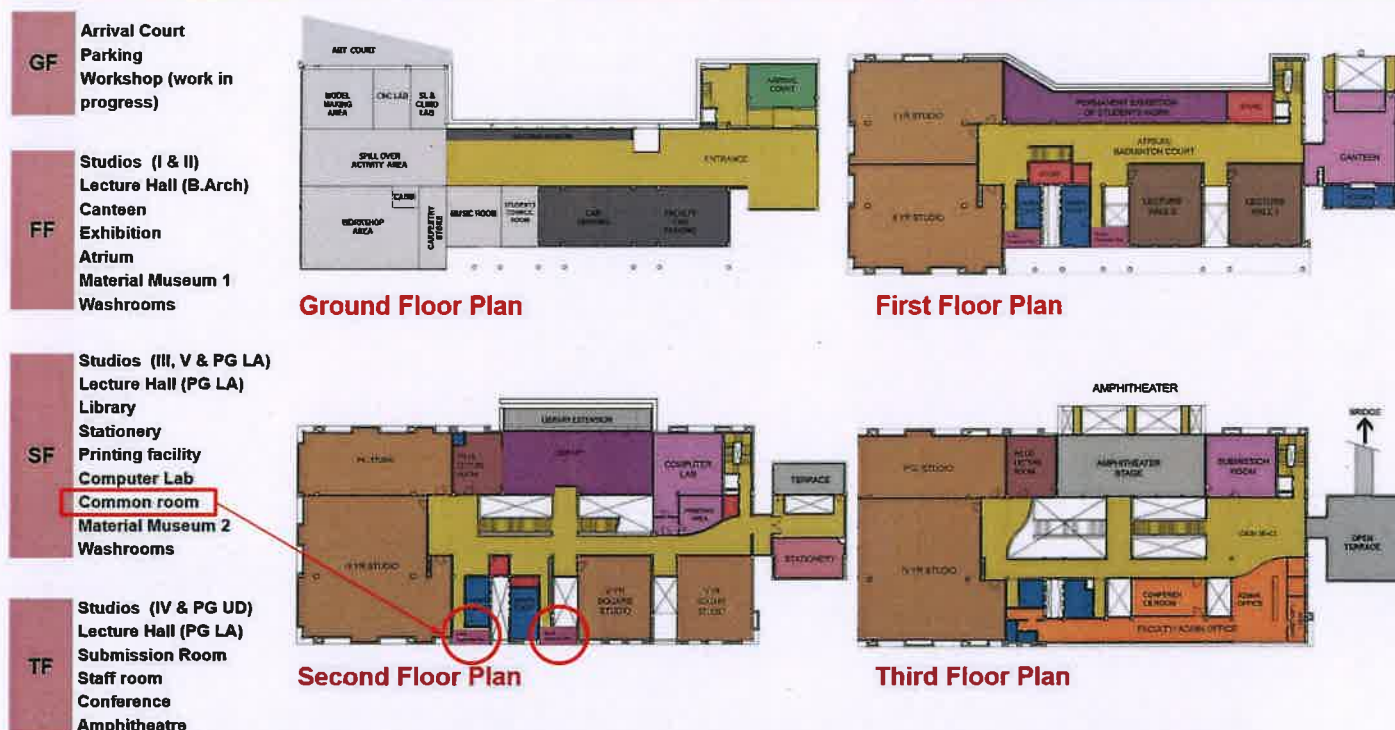
