



Exit Exhibition 2023 was inaugurated on *14th July 2023* at 6pm by honourable President of Council of Architecture Shri. Abhay Purohit.






1.4] Exit Exhibition 2023 - 'Careers Beyond' Session

The online classes for the M.Arch. Urban Design program (2nd Year, Sem I) at PVPCoA were conducted by Visiting Faculty Rahee Shruti Ganesh during September 2023. These sessions focused on the subject "Introduction to Constitution (ITC)," engaging students in discussions on foundational constitutional topics and India's history.


Key highlights include:

6.1] Site Visit to SWaCH's waste recycling





The 4th-year students and faculty visited SWaCH's waste recycling trail to witness the city's garbage handling process firsthand. Accompanied by waste-pickers, they experienced the PMC's waste collection and sorting methods. This interaction aimed to deepen their understanding of waste segregation civic importance and its impact on livelihoods. The trail included visits to a Door-to-Door Waste Collection facility, Composting for the residential Society, Pinjara, Biogas Plant & Plastic waste collection system, concluding with a debriefing at Kothrud Kachra Depot Accitionally, they visited the V-Collect center in Aundh, which recycles unused household items, electronics, and furniture, reducing landfill waste.


